
The personal edge that Micaela brings to each painting changes and enhances recognisable subject matter, cultivating an imaginative, visual experience for the viewer.


The rivers we have swam, the people we have been, have moulded us to who we are today. And rather than forgetting that, we embrace it.



The Rebirth of ones soul. Prosperity and abundance of happiness to come.



The Rebirth, releasing what God/the universe intended for you.



You're home.








